Things about Lutherans

One winter evening, Martin Luther saw starlight reflecting off ice on an evergreen tree. He put a tree in the living room and added candles to the branches to simulate the starlight and is credited with the first indoor tree! In 1610, tinsel, made from real silver, was invented in Germany. In the late 1800's artificial trees were created in Germany using metal wires covered with goose, turkey, ostrich or swan feathers dyed green to imitate pine needles. In the 1930's, the Addis Brush Company created the first artificial-brush tree using the same machine that made toilet brushes! In 1917 Albert Sadacca was fifteen years old when he got the idea to make safe Christmas tree lights (only 100 sets were sold the first year). In 1957, H. W. Spencer used Chrismons (monograms of Christ) to tell the story of Jesus.
